Dear Highmoor Parish Council,

I am writing to you on behalf of a Henley based charity called Millie's Dream, founded in 2013 by Sarah Roberts after her daughter was diagnosed with a heart and lung condition. Millie's Dream is responsible for installing, to date, eighty five lifesaving defibrillator devices located around the Henley area including the one at Highmoor Memorial Hall.

Would the Parish Council consider a one off or annual grant towards the ongoing maintenance costs of the defibrillator which is the interests of, and could bring direct benefit to, the people of Highmoor. The costs are roughly £125 per year for the batteries and pads which last roughly 2 years and the electricity is £25 per year to maintain light and heater.
