

Highmoor Memorial Hall Annual Report 2022-23 23-09-28

This report covers the period from Sept 2022 to Aug 31st 2023.

Highmoor Nursery School makes use of the hall for the majority of the time while the Parish Council continues to hold meetings in the hall, but we have no other occasional users apart from the village quiz team again.

We ended the year with a balance of £12245.61 very slightly up from £11954.37 at the start of the year.

During the year we have had new side blinds installed in all the windows of the hall, replacing the faded curtains. A new water heater has been fitted, as the old one was leaking. We continue to monitor our use of electricity carefully.

The defibrillator outside the building has been refreshed this year with help from the charity Millie's Dream, the Parish Council and Debbie Warren-Price, who will review its status in the future.

We will still be looking into the possibility of using some form of solar power, though maybe just for water. We will need to repair the flat roofing soon, as it has occasionally leaked in extreme weather and we will need to look into the rainwater drainage as well.

We continue with a committee of three, which has allowed us to make decisions quickly over times when we can't actually get together.

Support from the Parish Council is always very welcome and useful.
