

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HIGHMOOR AND ROTHERFIELDS AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads – is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** in Highmoor, replacing the majority of the existing 30mph speed limit in the process, leading out to the following points:

1. B481:
 - a. Northern end – a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to Highmoor Memorial Hall,
 - b. Southern end – a point 340 metres south of Holly Close.
2. Witheridge Hill:
 - a. Northern section – its junction with Newnhamhill Bottom,
 - b. Southern section – a point 25 metres north of Colmore Lane.

Part of the existing 30mph speed limit will remain on the B481 Nettlebed to Reading Road leading northwards out of the village, with Officers having taken the current road environment into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Highmoor and Rotherfields Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
