

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HIGHMOOR AND ROTHERFIELDS AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

The Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Highmoor and Rotherfields Area) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
6. The Oxfordshire County Council (Highmoor and Rotherfields Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit:

Highmoor

The whole length of every road in the village of Highmoor (excluding any roads specified in Schedules 2 or 3 of this order) extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	B481 (northern end)	a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to Highmoor Memorial Hall
b)	B481 (southern end)	a point 340 metres south of its junction with Holly Close
c)	Witheridge Hill (northern section)	its junction with Newnhamhill Bottom
d)	Witheridge Hill (southern section)	a point 25 metres north of its junction with Colmore Lane

SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit:

Highmoor

a)	B481 Nettlebed to Reading Road	from the entrance to Highmoor Hall, southwards	to a point 340 metres south of its junction with Holly Close a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to Highmoor Memorial Hall
b)	Greys Green to Satwell Road	from its junction with B481 Nettlebed to Reading road, westwards	to a point 105 metres west of Satwell Close in the Parish of Rotherfield Greys.
c)	Unnamed road	from its junction with B481, Nettlebed to Reading road, northwards	to its junction with the Greys Green to Satwell Road at The Lamb Public house, a distance of 103 metres.
d)	Holly Close	for its entire length.	
e)	Unnamed Road	from its junction with B481 Nettlebed to Reading Road at	for a distance of 940 metres (to a point 50 metres north of the property known as The Old

		Highmoor Cross, southwest and northwards	Place), Witheridge Hill Common area
f)	The unnamed road through Witheridge Hill	from its junction with the unnamed road at e) above, westwards	To its junction with the roads to Highmoor Cross, Newnham Hill and Stoke Row Road.

Rotherfield Greys

a)	Bolts Cross to Henley Road	from a point 220 metres east of its junction with B481 Nettlebed to Sonning Common road, eastwards	to a point 145 metres south of its junction with Rocky Lane
b)	Greys Green to Rotherfield Greys Road	from its junction with the Bolts Cross to Henley Road at the war memorial	to a point 100 metres southeast of its junction with Church Close
c)	Greys Green to Satwell Road	from its junction with the Bolts Cross to Henley Road, westwards	to a point 105 metres west of Satwell Close
d)	Satwell Close	for its entire length	
e)	Unnamed Road	from its junction with the Bolts Cross to Henley Road	to its junction with The Greys Green to Rotherfield Greys Road, a distance of 135 metres.

Rotherfield Peppard

a)	B481, Nettlebed to Reading Road	from its junction at Hillcrest	to a point 50 metres north of the property known as Grass Lands
c)	Church Lane	from its north and south junctions with the B481	to a point 50 metres east of its junction with Grange Avenue
d)	Colliers Lane	from its junction with Stoke Row Road, eastwards	to its junction with B481
e)	Colmore Lane	from its junction with Colliers Lane, northwards	For a distance of 1,010 metres (40 metres past the property entrance of Woodlands)
f)	Drays Lane	for its entire length	

g)	Grange Avenue	for its entire length	
h)	Lower Hill	from its junction with Stoke Row Road	to its junction with the B481 Nettlebed to Reading road
i)	Priory Copse	for its entire length	
j)	Stoke Row Road	from a point 208 metres south of its junction with Wyfold Lane	to a point 70 metres northwest of its junction with Henley Court
k)	Unnamed Road	from its junction with Colliers Lane	to its junction with the B481 Nettlebed to Reading road
l)	Wyfold Lane	(i) from a point 50 metres east of its junction with the entrance to Wyfold Grange	to a point 435 metres southwest
		(ii) from its junction with Stoke Row Road	to its junction with Chiltern Road.

SCHEDULE 3

40mph speed limit:

Rotherfield Peppard

a)	Stoke Row to Sonning Common road	from a point 801 metres northwest of its junction with the B481 Nettlebed to Reading Road, north-westwards	for a distance of 946 metres
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Rotherfield Greys

a)	B481 Nettlebed to Sonning Common Road	From a point 260 metres north of its junction with the Bolts Cross to Henley Road	to a point 220 metres south of its junction with the Bolts Cross to Henley Road
b)	Bolts Cross to Henley Road	from its junction with the B481 Nettlebed to Sonning Common road, eastwards	for a distance of 220 metres.
